DEAN'S DIRECTIVE No. 8/2011

Activity of Students in the Faculty Building After Business Hours

Article I

Subject of the Regulation

This Directive regulates the conditions of stay for students in the building of the Third Faculty of Medicine in Prague, Ruská 87, Prague 10 (hereinafter also referred to as the "building") in the period after regular business hours. Such period means (for the purpose of this Directive) the period from 8 pm to 7 am of the following day on business days, and from 7 am to 7 am of the following day on public holidays.

Article II

Stay of Students in the Computer Room

Students are entitled to use Computer Room No. 222 in the period from 6 am to 8 pm daily including public holidays.

Article III

Stay of Students in Other Building Premises

1) Students are entitled to use the following classrooms and seminar rooms for self-study: 220, 221, 331, 422, 423 and 525, principally after the end of lessons. Keys to the aforementioned classrooms will be issued to a student by the porter upon submitting a student card.

2) Students are also entitled to use the common premises on the ground floor and on the 6^{th} floor of the building for self-study.

3) The premises specified in clauses 1) and 2) of this Article may be used by students until 12 pm on business days and from 7 am to 12 pm of the following day on public holidays. Students must not stay in the faculty building after and before the above-specified periods on non-business days.

Article IV

Rules of Student Conduct

1) When staying in the building after regular business hours, students must identify themselves with their student cards upon the request of security service personnel.

2) When staying in the building after regular business hours, students may only stay in the rooms specified in Article III of this Directive.

Article V

Final Provisions

1) An exception from this Directive may only be granted by the Faculty Secretary on the basis of the student's written application and after receiving the point of view from the the faculty's site manager.

2) This Directive does not alter any Internal Regulation.

3) This Directive shall come into force on the day of its signing and into effect on 3 October 2011.
